We have started an evening support group on the 1st Wednesday of every month please see attached flyer for more details on caregiver support programs and community forums.

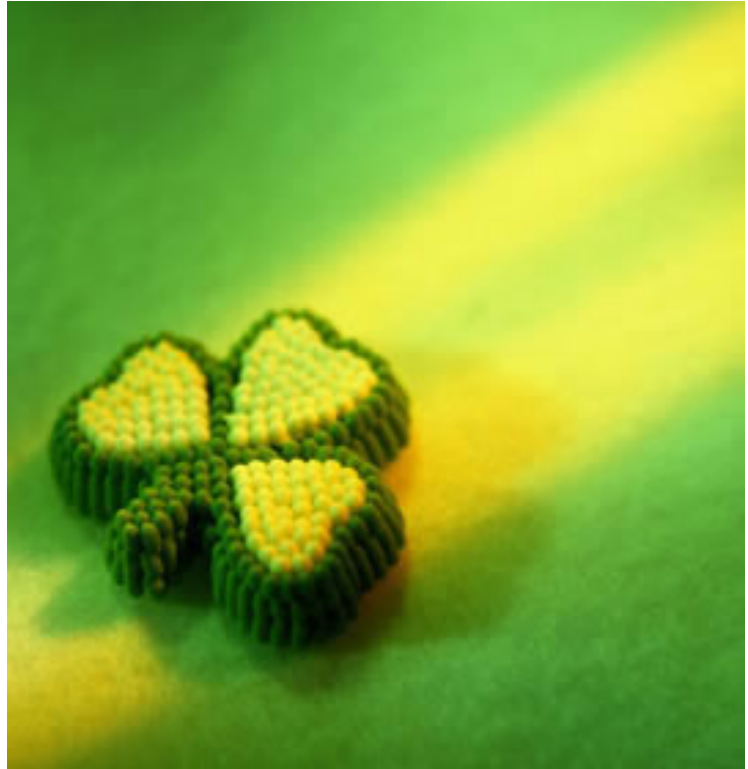

Irish Vegetable Stew

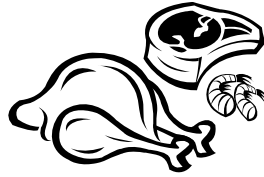
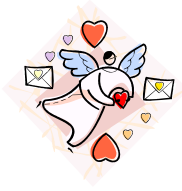
Ingredients:

½ cup broccoli florets
½ cup carrots (sliced)
½ cauliflorets
¼ cup pimienta (chopped)
salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

Combine bay leaf, water, and wine vinegar in medium saucepan. Bring to a boil; add vegetables. Simmer until vegetables are tender. Drain; remove bay leaf. Add salt and pepper.

The food relief program is open to one and all. Anyone may purchase an unlimited number of boxes of Angel Food by placing an order with a local Angel Food host site. **ORDER ONLINE www.angelfoodministries.com**

Comparison shopping nationwide in various grocery stores has revealed that the average retail value of a \$31 Angel Food Box for the same food items would be approximately \$65. Generally, one box of Angel Food assists in feeding a family of four for about one week or a single senior citizen for almost a month. To better help families in need, Angel Food Ministries participates in the food stamp program.

Food is available for pickup usually the last Saturday of the month. Orders must be purchased in advance around the 15th of the month. Credit cards may be used online; cash and food stamps may be used at one of the local locations. Call or go online for current information and menus (available in Spanish and English).
